**Eligibility Conditions:**

1. A student having a pass in S.S.L.C. or its equivalent examination is eligible to take admission to P.U.C. I year. Students should apply in the prescribed form along with certified copies of Marks Card, Caste Certificate, Leaving Certificate and Certificates of outstanding performance, if any.
2. The students who have passed P.U.C. I year district level examination conducted by the college are eligible to take admission to P.U.C. II year.
3. There is no provision for change of subject(s) at P.U.C. II year and students must study the same subjects studied in P.U.C. I year.
4. Minimum of 75% attendance for regular classes and attendance for Quarterly / Terminal / Preliminary tests are compulsory.
5. At the end of the two year course there will be a public examination conducted by the Department of Pre-University Education, Bangalore.

## **Two year Diploma Course in Sericulture**

P.U.D.C. I Year	:	Intake 30 students only

### **Eligibility Conditions**

1. A student pass in S.S.L.C. or its equivalent examination is eligible to take admission to P.U.D.C. I year. Students should apply in the prescribed form along with certified copies of Marks Card, Caste Certificate, Leaving Certificate and Certificates of outstanding performance, if any.
2. Department of Vocational Education, Bangalore will conduct examinations for both the year.
3. Students should undergo periodical tests, practical examinations and training in Silkworm rearing.

**ONE YEAR POST GRADUATE DIPLOMA COURSE**

### **Post Graduate Diploma in Computer Application (P.G.D.C.A.)**

- The college offers P.G.D.C.A. course. Students with any Bachelor degree with a minimum of 45% (40% for SC / ST / Cat-I) are eligible for admission.
- Out of maximum 45 intake 22 students under Management quota and 23 students sponsored by the Karnatak University will be admitted to the course.
- Students seeking admission under the Management quota will be admitted on first cum first served basis. For taking admission under the Karnatak University quota students should apply directly to the University in the prescribed application form on or before the last date fixed and appear for entrance test at the University campus on the date fixed by the University.
