Following are the activities carried out by the QAC after NAAC accreditation.

1. Three members of the staff namely, Dr. S. S. Suvarnakhandi, Dr. T. P. Giraddi and Prof. M. C. Karabari have attended the NAAC sponsored two-day national seminar cum workshop on "Improving Quality of Teaching and Learning in the classroom" organised by Mahatma Gandhi Memorial College, Udapi during March 22-23, 2004.
2. Conducted a day workshop on Quality Circles of colleges in Bagalkot district on 3-4-2004. The workshop was organised under the joint auspices of District Level Task Force – TQM / HRD, Bagalkot and this college. Dr. Smt. M. R. Chandawarkar, Convenor, DLTF, Bagalkot took the lead. Mr. K. S. Prabhakar, Deputy Commissioner, Bagalkot and President of DLTF inaugurated the workshop and delivered the inaugural speech. Dr. G. V. Udupudi, Member of Local Advisory Governing Body of this college delivered a

keynote address. Prof. N. G. Karur, working President of DLTF was the chief guest. More than 200 teachers from colleges of Bagalkot and Bijapur twin district attended the workshop. It was a grand success.

3. 45-day summer cricket coaching camp for school and college children under the age group of 16-22 has been conducted. About 40 children participated in the camp. The closing function of this camp was held on 31-5-2004 and the certificates of participation were issued to all the participants.
4. Computer coaching camp for one and half month for school children has been conducted during the summer vacation. The Basics of the Computer has been taught and test examination was conducted. Certificates were issued to all the successful candidates.
5. Inaugurated the academic activities of the college for the academic year 2004-05 on 18-6-2004. His holiness Dr. Mahadev Shivacharya Swamiji of Brahanmath, Babaleshwar graced the occasion by performing Maha Saraswati Pooja and lighted the lamp to mark the beginning of academic activities for the year.
6. A 3-day workshop on "Creative Teaching" was organised under the joint auspices of this college and iACT Bangalore for the benefit of teachers of this college during June 25-27, 2004. Dr. Gururaj Karjagi, Director, iACT, Bangalore was resource person for complete 3 days. Teachers gained wonderful experience from this workshop.
7. Teachers of the college have voluntarily contributed Rs. 1,000/- each for implementation of quality management activities in the college. The amount would be utilised for extending financial support to few poor and bright students of the college.
8. Planted about 200 sapples of all kinds in the college campus on the occasion of 57th Independence Day celebration i.e. on Aug. 15, 2004. Dr. M. T. Kamble, Professor of History, Karnatak University, Dharwad was the guest of honour on the occasion.
9. Regular activities of the N.S.S. unit of this college for the year 2004-05 was inaugurated on 1-9-2004. Mr. C. G. Patil, Tahasildar was the Chief Guest.
10. Two of our staff members namely Dr. S. S. Suvarnakhandi and Dr. B. M. Kalshetty have attended as resource persons in a day workshop organised by Basaveshwar Science College, Bagalkot for teachers in the Pre-University colleges of Bagalkot district.
11. A two-day workshop for teachers of Bagalkot district teaching Kannada, English and Economics subjects was organised jointly by this college and Dept. of Pre-University Education, Bagalkot District On Sept. 3-4, 2004 and equipped the teachers with the new syllabi, new question paper model and with the new system of assigning internal marks

introduced from the current academic year. Mr. S. P. Nayak, District Dy. Director of Pre-University Education inaugurated the workshop. About 150 teachers from the entire Bagalkot district attended the workshop.

12. Under the auspices of College Union Birth Centenary of National Poet Laureate Kuvempu was celebrated on Sept. 7, 2004. Professor and Poet Dr. Gurupad Mareguddi of Sankeshwar was the chief guest.
13. 'Hindi Day' was celebrated under the auspices of Department of Hindi of this college on Sept. 10, 2004. Mr. Purushottam Lele, Airforce Officer (Rtd.) was the chief guest. Importance of national language Hindi in promoting unity and integrity of Indians was highlighted.
14. Two members of the staff namely Prin. S. H. Lagali and Dr. S. S. Suvarnakhadi have attended two-day national seminar on "Autonomy for colleges : New Dimensions" organised by S.B.R.R. Mahajana First Grade College, Mysore during Sept. 10-11, 2004.
15. To create and co-ordinate environment awareness programmes and activities in and around Jamkhandi a new association in the name of "Nature Club" was started on Sept 17, 2004 and it was inaugurated by former Rotary Governor Rtn. Dr. G. V. Udupudi. As a mark of beginning of functioning of nature club Dr. Udupudi delivered a lecture on rainwater harvesting and management on the occasion.
16. One of the faculty member namely Dr. T. P. Giraddi has attended two-day workshop on "Global Concepts in Education for Educational Institutes ISO 9001 : 2000 perspective" during Sept., 20-21, 2004 conducted by Qualigram, Belgaum.
17. The activities of college union and sports for the year 2004-05 and newly constructed computer laboratory building were inaugurated at the holy hands of Dr. (Smt.) Sayeeda Akhtar, Vice-Chancellor, Karnataka State Women University, Bijapur on Sept. 22, 2004.
18. Educational Sub-Committee of L.A.G.B. has met under the Chairmanship of Dr. G. V. Udupudi on Sept. 23, 2004 at 4 pm. in the staff room of the college. The heads of all the departments were present. The college results of April / May 2004 examination were analysed on 1:1 basis and committee expressed its happiness over the performance of the students in the examination and some important suggestions were made for further improvement in the results in few subjects.
19. Local Advisory Governing Body of the college has met twice in this academic year. The first meeting has held on 10-5-2004 and the second meeting on 24-9-2004. Some important decisions were taken to augument the existing activities in the college.

20. A day workshop on post NAAC activities in the college was organised jointly by this college and Department of Collegiate Education in Karnataka on 8-10-2004 for the benefit of college teachers in Bagalkot district. Dr. Y. M. Jayaraj, Special Officer for NAAC accreditation, Dr. (Smt.) M. R. Chandawarkar, Convenor, D.L.T.F., Bagalkot, Mr. Soumyakumar, Asst. Director of Collegiate Education, Regional Office, Dharwad were the resource persons. 154 teachers from colleges in Bagalkot district attended the workshop.
21. Conducted 10 day N.S.S. special annual camping programme in the adopted village Hipparagi from Oct. 8, 2004 to Oct. 17, 2004.
22. Mr. N. S. Kakhandaki, Librarian of our college has successfully completed the 5-day INFLIBNET Regional Training Programme on Library Automation which was held at Karnataka State Women University, Bijapur during Nov. 2-6, 2004.
23. Two staff members namely Dr. T. P. Giraddi and Prof. (Smt.) B. H. Kulkarni have attended two-day national seminar on Higher Education in India – Emerging Challenges organised by K.L.E. Society's Lingaraj College, Belgaum on Nov. 20-21, 2004.
24. Two staff members namely Dr. T. P. Giraddi and Dr. S. G. Hiremath have attended 2-day NAAC sponsored national seminar on GATS – Impact India conducted by B. M. College of Commerce, Pune during Dec. 6-7, 2004.
25. Two staff members namely Dr. S. G. Hiremath and Prof. D. B. Hirekurubar have attended two-day national seminar on WTO organised by Department of Commerce, Karnatak University, Dharwad during Dec. 24-25, 2004
26. Five staff members of the college namely Prof. B. K. Biradar, Dr. S. S. Suvarnakhandi, Dr. S. A. Kadi, Dr. B. M. Kalshetty and Dr. T. P. Giraddi have attended a day workshop on Science Curriculum and Teaching Methodologies organised jointly by D.L.T.F., Bagalkot and Bhandari & Rathi College, Guledagudd on 12-01-2005. Dr. T. P. Giraddi was one of the resource persons.
27. The college has conducted two test examinations for all the classes in all the subjects in this academic year so far.
28. The college has submitted number of proposals e.g. proposal for construction of ladies hostel, construction of classroom under special scheme of educationally backward area, computer networking in the college for financial assistance to various funding agencies to undertake new projects and the responses are awaited. The proposal for construction of ladies hostel was accepted by the UGC and the first installment grant of Rs. 10 lakh has

been released. All the preliminary processes like calling tender, allocation of work to the civil contractors etc. are over and the construction work is about to begin.

29. The construction of swimming pool at the estimated cost of Rs. 46.46 lakh under the partial financial assistance from The Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Govt. of India and construction of classrooms under financial assistance from UGC during X Plan period are in full progress.
30. Seven sportsmen i.e. 3 cyclists, 1 athlete (cross country), 1 lawn tennis player, and 2 swimmers have been selected as University players and two players are in reserve i.e. one in wrestling another in chess.
31. Mr. T. S. Mali, Athlete of this college has captained the Karnatak University Cross Country team in All India Level Tournament which was held in Gulbarga and the team secured IV place at All India Level.
32. Proposals for financial assistance for carrying out minor research projects are submitted by 17 staff members of the college to the UGC. Sanction is awaited.

#### **Future Plans :**

1. NAAC sponsored State / National level seminar is being organized during the month of July / August 2005.
2. Website of the college is to be launched very soon for providing brief information regarding the college.
