PART A

The IQAC met in the chamber of the Principal on 15-7-2006 to review the future plans set for the academic year 2006-07 and to chalk out the plan of action for the academic year 2007-08 for enhancement of quality of higher education in the college.

The plan of action :

1. Decided to organise NAAC sponsored two-day State Level seminar on 'Women Empowerment' and Bijapur-Bagalkot twin district level a-day seminar for the benefit of the Physical Directors.
2. Decided to construct four classrooms in the open space behind the main building instead of proposed construction on the first floor of the existing main building.
3. Decided to start career oriented Add-on-courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology under the financial assistance from UGC.
4. Decided to provide broad band facility in the college library for use with staff and students.
5. Decided to start P.G. course in Electronics and to introduce Bio-Technology and Micro-Biology subjects at the U.G. level from the academic year 2007-08.
6. Decided to request the authorities of B.L.D.E. Association to include college information in the common website for group of Association's institutions to be launched by the Association.
7. Decided to apply and request the authorities of Karnatak University for grant of permission to host Karnatak University Single Zone Swimming Competition, Single Zone Weight Lifting and Body Building Competitions.
8. Decided to apply to UGC for financial assistances for extension of existing Womens' Hostel.
9. Decided to start students exchange study programme in the college by inviting / sending students from / to nearby colleges in Bijapur and Bagalkot districts.
10. Decided to continue training programme for students to train them for campus interviews to be conducted by B.P.O.s and other private agencies.
11. Steps to be initiated for purchase of books, equipments etc.

12. Teachers to be permitted to attend state, national level seminars, conferences and workshops to be held elsewhere.
13. Students should be encouraged and provided with full facilities for participation of sports meet, tournaments etc.
14. Efforts should be continued to complete construction of building projects like classrooms etc.
15. Students should be encouraged to take part in extra curricular activities like NCC, NSS, debate, elocution, cultural activities etc.
16. Publication of college miscellany to be continued.
17. Classroom teaching should be given priority, so that, completion of syllabi, conducting of tests, tutorials, seminars etc. can go uninterrupted and prepare students for their examination.
18. Teachers and students should be encouraged to take part in all such activities, which help keep them updated.

Achievement :

A meeting of the members of IQAC was held in the chamber of the Principal on 30-6-2007 and discussed the achievement of the plan of action for the year 2006-07. The committee examined and verified documents pertaining to the achievements of the college got confirmed the same. Committee resolved unanimously to thank staff for their pains taking efforts in achieving the chosen goals for the academic year.

PART B

1. The college has continued its effort to provide quality education to the students, majority of them being from rural area.
2. Introduction of Add-on-courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology at UG level and introduction of PG course in Electronics are in full progress.
3. One staff member (Prof. B. M. Nuchhi) has been awarded Ph.D. degree in his subject, one staff member has submitted his Ph.D. thesis for the award of degree and three staff members have completed M.Phil. degrees in their subjects under F.I.P. of U.G.C. during the academic year.
4. A day seminar on "Importance of Sports Activities in Colleges" was organized on 24-3-2007 under joint auspices of this college and D.L.T.F. of Bijapur and Bagalkot twin districts for the benefit of Physical Directors and Staff members (who are involved actively in the sports activities of the college) of all the Degree colleges located in Bijapur and Bagalkot districts.
5. Four staff members have completed successfully minor research projects funded by U.G.C.
6. Prof. K. S. Patil has written one text book for B.Com. students.
7. Mr. S. R. Rathod, past student of this college has passed SLET exam for lecturership in Economics conducted by Kuvempu University on 16-4-2006.
8. The college has continued its support towards generating funds for poor students aid fund, for which teaching staff members have contributed Rs. 1000/- each. A huge amount generated was paid to needy poor but brilliant students to meet their partial educational expenses.
9. NCC / NSS units of the college have rendered remarkable social service. A 10-day NSS camp was organised in the adopt village Kalahalli near Jamkhandi during Oct. 8-17, 2006.

10. Library was kept open night upto 9 pm. during the examination days. New books worth approximately Rs. 3 lakh were purchased and subscription of 19 journals were renewed.
11. Guest faculties were recruited on consolidated salary. Teaching and Non-Teaching staff is approximately 2:1.
12. Confidential feedbacks from the students about the teachers were taken and the comments made by the students were brought to the notices of the concerned teachers personally.
13. Unit cost of education during this academic year turns to be about Rs. 5,000/-.
14. The college has conducted examination during the year 2006-07 and has maintained discipline, secrecy and sanctity of the examination, so that, not even single mall practice case was detected by the external squad, sitting squad etc.
15. Constructions of 4 classrooms and two mini halls were undertaken. All the 4 classrooms are put into use.
16. Computer Internet facility is available in the college and teachers and students used to access it.
17. The college was able to provide financial support to large number of students in the form of scholarships, cash prizes, out of the interest earned on huge amount kept in the form of fixed deposit in banks. The scholarship available through Government department like National Scholarship, C. V. Raman Scholarship etc. were made availed by the students.
18. Alumni Association of the college has instituted cash prizes to those students, who exhibit outstanding performance in academic and in sports. The college has borne the fees of all the sports persons.
19. A batch of students from Department of Political Science were sent to Belgaum as spectators for Karnataka Government Assembly session which was held outside Bangalore for the first time. It was an unique opportunity for our students.
20. A bunch of students from Department of History were sent to Hampi Ustav, which was an historic event.

21. The performance of the students in examination April 2006 was excellent. The average pass percentage of the students in B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. examination was above 80%. One of the students by name Miss. Pinky Shah has secured 1st rank at University level in B.Sc. examination, April 2006.

22. The college has hosted Karnatak University Single Zone Swimming Competition during August 29-30, 2006 and Single Zone Weight Lifting and Body Building Competition during September 25-26, 2006. Both the meets were grand success.

The Swimming team of the college secured first place in the meet. Similarly Kabaddi & Wrestling teams of the college have secured championship and Runners-up in Weight Lifting & Cycling in the Karnatak University Inter-Collegiate Tournaments.

All together fourteen sports persons of the college have been selected in the University team and played for University in Inter-University Meets. Eight NCC cadets have attended Pre R.D. parade at Bellary and six cadets have attended tracking camp which was held in Goa.

23. Conducted two Blood Donation camps, one on 30-10-2006 under the joint auspices of District Hospital, Bijapur and one more on 6-1-2007 under the auspices of Sri B. M. Patil Medical College, Bijapur.

24. About 150 saplings were planted in the college campus by the NSS volunteers.

25. Remedial courses were conducted for the benefit of slow learners. Global skill enhancement training was given to about 150 students for two and half months and prepared them for facing campus interview to be conducted by Infosys and other B.P.O's. About 26 students have been selected in the campus interviews.

26. Remedial coaching for SC / ST students of the college was organised for the period of more than three months under the financial assistance from UGC.

27. Teachers were permitted to attend state / national level seminars and most of them have attended one or the other.

In all the academic year 2006-07 has brought name, fame and dividend for the college.

1. Apply for grant of Autonomy.
2. Conduct of Karnatak University Single Zone Cycling Tournament.
3. Construction of eight more classrooms on the first floor of the existing main building.
4. Efforts to be continued for starting of Bio-Technology and Micro-Biology subjects at UG level and PG course in Electronics.
5. Establishment of Digital Computer Laboratory.
6. Installation of Saraswati idol in the space inside the main gate.
