PART A

The IQAC met in the chamber of the Principal on 14-8-2007 to review the future plans set for the academic year 2007-08 and to chalk out the plan of action for the academic year 2008-09 for enhancement of quality of higher education in the college.

The plan of action :

1. Decided to launch website of the college giving all information.
2. Decided to conduct two-day State level seminar on "Das Literature".
3. Decided to extend career oriented Add-on-courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology under the financial assistance from UGC leading to award of Diploma certificate.
4. Decided to construct four classrooms in the open space behind the main building.
5. Decided to apply and request the authorities of Karnatak University for grant of permission to host Karnatak University Single Zone Competitions in atleast two games/sports.
6. Decided to apply to UGC for developmental grants during XI Plan period.
7. Decided to give training for Non-Teaching staff in accounting using Tally software.
8. Decided to give training for Non-Teaching staff in Communication Skill and Spoken English.
9. Decided to continue training programme for students to train them for campus interviews to be conducted by B.P.O.s and other private agencies.
10. Steps to be initiated for purchase of books, equipments etc.
11. Teachers to be permitted to attend state, national level seminars, conferences and workshops to be held elsewhere.
12. Students should be encouraged and provided with full facilities for participation of sports meet, tournaments etc.

13. Students should be encouraged to take part in extra curricular activities like NCC, NSS, debate, elocution, cultural activities etc.
14. Publication of college miscellany to be continued.
15. Classroom teaching should be given priority, so that, completion of syllabi, conducting of tests, tutorials, seminars etc. can go uninterrupted and prepare students for their examination.
16. Teachers and students should be encouraged to take part in all such activities, which help keep them updated.

Achievement :

A meeting of the members of IQAC was held in the chamber of the Principal on 30-7-2008 and discussed the achievement of the plan of action for the year 2007-08. The committee examined and verified documents pertaining to the achievements of the college and got confirmed the same. Committee resolved unanimously to thank staff for their pains taking efforts in achieving the chosen goals for the academic year 2007-08.

PART B

1. UGC Sponsored Add-on Courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology were introduced after obtaining affiliation notification from the Karnatak University. These courses lead to the award of Certificate for the successful candidates.
2. Karnatak University Single Zone Cycling Championship was held under the auspices of the college during October 8-9, 2007. The college team bagged Runners Up place in the championship. Mr. P. M. Hirekurbar bagged individual championship and 4 cyclists were selected in the University team.
3. A 3-day Internet World Programme was organised for the benefit of High School students from three talukas of Jamkhandi Sub-Division during October 29-31, 2007.
4. New office bearers were elected for Alumni association of the College on 10-11-2007. Prof. B. I. Kaddi and Dr. T.P. Giraddi were elected as President and General Secretary respectively. Other office bearers were also elected.
5. A day programme both for students and teachers was organised under the auspices of Alumni association of the college on 26/11/2007. Dr. Gururaj Karajagi, a well known educationist and Director of ACT, Bangalore was the resource person. During the morning session, Dr. Karjagi sir delivered lecture on "Students' Career Building". He was successful in impressing the students and made them to work hard in achieving their chosen goal. During evening session on the same day he conducted the workshop for teachers on "Innovative methods of Teaching". This has made the teachers more active and creative in their teaching.

6. NCC / NSS units of the college have rendered remarkable social service. A 10-day NSS camp was organised in the adopt village Sanaal near Jamkhandi during December 14-23, 2007.
7. National Science Day celebration was organised for the benefit of all the science students of the college on 28-2-2008. Dr. V. M. Jali, Reader in Physics, Gulbarga University was a Chief Guest.
8. Students of the Commerce wing of the college organised a 6-day "Mega Trade and Promotional Expo 2007-08" during March 14-19, 2008. Various products and goods were sold through 72 stalls established by local business people and transacted lakhs of rupees of business. Students were given exposure towards ins and outs of business.
9. Public awareness programme on "Atoms for peace" was organised in association with Indian Association for Radiation Protection on 23-4-2008. Senior scientists Dr. R. Naturam from B.A.R.C. and Dr. A. H. Khan from I.A.R.P. were the resource persons. All the students from the Science streams benefited the programme.
10. Two month Summer Vacation Camp for Swimming Coaching was organised for the benefit of school children of the Jamkhandi city during April and May 2008.
11. Extended part of construction of Women hostel is in full progress. Construction was being undertaken under UGC assistance during X plan. Part of it has already been put into use by accommodating lady students. Construction work is expected to be complete before February 2009.
12. Construction of 3 more classrooms in the college campus i.e. behind the main building is in full progress and construction work of ground floor is complete in all respect and construction of another 3 rooms on its first floor is in full swing.

13. Two girls namely Afreen Anure and Afroze Momin have secured first and second ranks to Karnatak University in B.Sc. Examinations 2007. Afreen Anure has scored record marks i.e. 94.73%.
14. The college Library and the college office are provided with Broadband facility. Students and staff are given Broadband facilities for their use.
15. Bio-Tech subject was introduced at B.Sc. first and second semester after obtaining affiliation notification from the Karnatak University w.e.f. the academic year 2007-08.
16. Students Exchange Study Programme was introduced in the college and invited/sent from/to nearby colleges in Bijpaur and Bagalkot Districts.
17. The college has continued its effort to provide quality education to the students, majority of them being from rural area.
18. One staff member (Prof. N. M. Rolli) has been awarded Ph.D. degree in his subject, three staff members have completed M.Phil. degrees in their subjects during the academic year.
19. The college has continued its support towards generating funds for poor students aid fund, for which teaching staff members have contributed Rs. 1000/- each. A huge amount generated was paid to needy poor but brilliant students to meet their partial educational expenses.
20. Library was kept open night upto 8 pm. during the examination days.
21. Guest faculties were recruited on consolidated salary. Teaching and Non-Teaching staff is approximately 2:1.
22. Confidential feedbacks from the students about the teachers were taken and the comments made by the students were brought to the notices of the concerned teachers personally.
23. Unit cost of education during this academic year turns to be about Rs. 5,000/-.

24. The college has conducted examination during the year 2007-08 and has maintained discipline, secrecy and sanctity of the examination, so that, not even single small practice case was detected by the external squad, sitting squad etc.
25. Computer Internet facility is available in the college and teachers and students used to access it.
26. The college was able to provide financial support to large number of students in the form of scholarships, cash prizes, out of the interest earned on huge amount kept in the form of fixed deposit in banks. The scholarship available through Government department like National Scholarship, C. V. Raman Scholarship etc. were made available by the students.
27. Alumni Association of the college has instituted cash prizes to those students, who exhibit outstanding performance in academic and in sports. The college has borne the fees of all the sports persons.
28. A batch of students from Department of Political Science were sent to Local Police Station and other local offices to know their working system.
29. The performance of the students in examination was excellent. The average pass percentage of the students in B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. examination was above 80%.
30. The Swimming team of the college secured championship successively second time in a row. 5 swimmers of the college were selected in the University Swimming team. Wrestling team has secured Runners up place in the Karnatak University Inter-Collegiate Tournament. Sadashiv Pakali was selected in the University team.

All together fourteen sports persons of the college have been selected in the University team and played for University in Inter-University Meets. 3 S.D. and 4 S.W. cadets from NCC have attended T.S.C. camp.

and 4 S.D. and one S.W. cadets have attended N.I.C. camp which was held in Gujarat.

31. Remedial courses were conducted for the benefit of slow learners. Global skill enhancement training was given to about 100 students for two and half months and prepared them for facing campus interview to be conducted by Eitan, Sun Microsys, Himat Singca and others and 26 students have been selected in the campus interviews.
32. Teachers were permitted to attend state / national level seminars and most of them have attended one or the other.
33. The college has applied to UGC for conferment of fresh Autonomous status to the college.
34. Digital Computer Laboratory has been established and 50 machines were installed.
35. Saraswati idol was installed in the main entrance of the college building. This has created traditional atmosphere among the students.
36. Students of all the science departments have participated in the Karnatak University level Science exhibition which was organised at G.S.S. College, Belgaum.

In all the academic year 2007-08 has brought name, fame and dividend for the college.
