PART A

The IQAC met in the chamber of the Principal on 4-8-2008 to review the future plans set for the academic year 2008-09 and to chalk out the plan of action for the academic year 2009-10 for enhancement of quality of higher education in the college.

The plan of action :

1. Decided to get the college re-accredited by the NAAC during the academic year 2009-10.
2. Decided to construct new Library building at the cost of Rs. 80 lakh as a centenary memorial building of the B.L.D.E. Association.
3. Decided to apply for starting PG courses in History and Political Science from the academic year 2010-11.
4. Decided to take library membership to INFLIBNET centre, Hyderabad.
5. Decided to extend career oriented Add-on-courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology under the financial assistance from UGC leading to award of Advanced Diploma.
6. Decided to apply and request the authorities of Karnatak University for grant of permission to host Karnatak University Single Zone Competitions in at least two games/sports.
7. Decided to continue training programme for students to train them for campus interviews to be conducted by B.P.O.s and other private agencies.

8. Steps to be initiated for purchase of books, equipments etc.
9. Teachers to be permitted to attend state, national level seminars, conferences and workshops to be held elsewhere.
10. Students should be encouraged and provided with full facilities for participation in sports meet, tournaments etc.
11. Students should be encouraged to take part in extra curricular activities like NCC, NSS, debate, elocution, cultural activities etc.
12. Publication of college miscellany to be continued.
13. Classroom teaching should be given priority, so that, completion of syllabi, conducting of tests, tutorials, seminars etc. can go uninterrupted and prepare students for their examination.
14. Teachers and students should be encouraged to take part in all such activities, which help keep them get updated.

Achievement :

A meeting of the members of IQAC was held in the chamber of the Principal on 3-8-2009 and discussed the achievement of the plan of action for the year 2008-09. The committee examined and verified documents pertaining to the achievements of the college and got confirmed the same. Committee resolved unanimously to thank staff for their pains taking efforts in achieving the chosen goals for the academic year 2008-09.

PART B

1. The college has launched its own website and the address is bldea.org/jkdcol
2. UGC Sponsored Add-on Courses in Tissue Culture, Sugar Science and Computer Technology leading to certificate courses were continued and diploma courses in the same subject were introduced during the academic year 2008-09.
3. Constructed classrooms and laboratory building to accommodate Botany, Zoology and Bio-Technology departments.
4. Karnatak University Inter-Collegiate Swimming Competitions were organized under the auspices of the college during September 10-11, 2008. The college team bagged Runners Up place in the championship. Jagadish Kallolli and Tulajappa Bangi selected in the University Swimming team.
5. Jagadish Kallolli, Tulajappa Bangi (Swimming-Men), Sikandar Hawaldar (Athletics), Basu Mali (Kho Kho), S. S. Kurani, M. M. Kurani (Cycling-Men), A. B. Kadapatti (Cross country) are the college players who have been selected as University Blues in their respective games / sports.
6. Applied in the prescribed format for the financial assistance from the UGC during XI Plan Period.
7. 3 non-teaching staff members were trained in Accounting using Tally software.

8. Non-teaching staff of the college were trained in Communication Skill and Spoken English.
9. A batch of 150 students was trained for campus interviews to be conducted by BPOs and other private firms.
10. Books worth Rs. 2,23,377/- and laboratory equipments worth Rs. 4,00,000/- are purchased.
11. Teachers were permitted to attend seminars, conferences and workshops.
12. Students were trained in various games and sports and supported with facilities.
13. 7 cadets have attended Thal Sena Camp. 6 cadets have attended National level Trekking camp which was held in Karwar.
14. 7-day NSS special service camp was organized in the adopted village Jakanur during March 25-31, 2009.
15. Brought out college miscellany 'Sambhod'.
16. National Science Day celebration was organized for the benefits of all the science students of the college on 28-2-2009. Padmashree Dr. Shivaram Bhoje, Former Director, IGCAR, Kalpakkam was the resource person.
17. College has conducted 2-month Summer Vacation Swimming Camp for school children during April-May, 2009.
18. Completed the construction work of women hostel, which is built under UGC assistance.

19. Miss. Shweta Kallur has scored highest marks in Physics at B.Sc. I and II Semesters.
20. 3 faculty members (Prof. B. I. Karalatti, Prof. P. S. Hiremath and Prof. S. K. Giregol) have obtained M.Phil. degree in their respective subjects.
21. Alumni Association has organized Annul Governing Body meeting on 29-10-2008.
22. A 3-day Internet World Programme was organised for the benefit of High School students from three talukas of Jamkhandi Sub-Division during November 4-6, 2008.
23. NCC / NSS units of the college have rendered remarkable social service.
24. Bio-Tech subject was extended to B.Sc. III and IV semesters the academic year 2008-09.
25. The college has continued its effort to provide quality education to the students, majority of them being from rural area.
26. The college has continued its support towards generating funds for poor students' aid fund, for which teaching staff members have contributed Rs. 1000/- each. A huge amount generated was paid to needy poor but brilliant students to meet their partial educational expenses.
27. Library was kept open night upto 8 pm. during the examination days.
28. Guest faculties were recruited on consolidated salary. Teaching and Non-Teaching staff is approximately 2:1.

29. Confidential feedbacks from the students about the teachers were taken and the comments made by the students were brought to the notices of the concerned teachers personally.
30. Unit cost of education during this academic year turns to be about Rs. 5,000/-.
31. The college has conducted examination during the year 2008-09 and has maintained discipline, secrecy and sanctity of the examination, so that, not even single small practice case was detected by the external squad, sitting squad etc.
32. Computer Internet facility is available in the college and teachers and students used to access it.
33. The college was able to provide financial support to large number of students in the form of scholarships, cash prizes, out of the interest earned on huge amount kept in the form of fixed deposit in banks. The scholarship available through Government department like National Scholarship, C. V. Raman Scholarship etc. were made available by the students.
34. The performance of the students in examination was excellent. The average pass percentage of the students in B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. examination was above 80%.
35. Remedial courses were conducted for the benefit of slow learners.

36. Students of all the science departments have participated in the Karnatak University level Science exhibition which was organised at Bhandari College, Guledagudd.

In all the academic year 2008-09 has brought name, fame and dividend for the college.

1. Conversion of existing Library building into Auditorium after completion of construction of new Library building.
2. Support to be extended for completion of UGC sponsored 9 MRPs.
