## **FACILITIES**

### **Faculty**

The learned faculty of this college is well qualified, trained and widely experienced. Each teacher has got deep concern for all round development of the student. The faculty members plan and prepare well for their classroom activities. Each teacher tries to ensure transparency and accountability.

### **College Gymkhana**

The Principal is the head of college gymkhana and chairpersons for various departments are nominated from the staff. Student representatives are also included in it. It organizes and conducts various activities like sports and games. The college union holds debate, elocution, social and cultural activities.

The college has got a vast playground suitable for all kinds of games. Adjacent to it there is a Taluka Stadium. Several sports persons of the college have reached international fame.

### **Library**

Our Library is housed in historically famous “Darbar Hall”. There are more than 45 thousand books worth around Rs. 30 lakh. News papers, periodicals and journals published in various languages are readily available for students’ use. Three months before the annual examination, Library will be kept open upto 9.00 pm. for studies. Issue part of the Library activity is computerized and two computers are kept for students use at the search point in the Library. Broadband facility is provided in the Library.

### **Laboratories**

Separate laboratory for each natural science subjects are well equipped and neatly maintained with modern instruments.

### **Multy-Gym**

The college offers the most perfectly equipped Gymnasium centre for both boys and girls on time division basis. A separate lady coach supervises the health fitness for girls. This facility is available for public, who fulfills the basic eligibility.

### **Swimming Pool**

Swimming pool has been constructed recently and is being used by student of our college and public of Jamkhandi.

### **S.W.O.**

This unit works for the welfare of the students. Training programmes on topics of current interest like Communication Skills and Personality Developments are being conducted. Books are distributed to the students in three categories.

3. SC and ST

Students Grievances Cell is also working under this unit. Notifications of employment opportunities and scholarships available are also notified as and when we receive.

### **Nature Club**

College is having Nature Club with the motto of creating the awareness regarding the environment.

### **N.C.C.**

This wing facilitates interested students to train themselves in discipline, leadership qualities and national security work. This wing has a proud record and has produced some noted cadets who have been serving in National Defence. For the last few years this facility has been extended to girls too.

### **N.S.S.**

About 100 service-minded students of both the sexes will be selected as N.S.S. volunteers. These volunteers will be trained and examined to prove their discipline, service, dedication and hard working nature for others. They are guided to take up social service responsibility.

### **INTERNET:**

The computer laboratory has Internet facility to acquaint the staff and the students with electronic communication world.

### **Medical Aid**

Health checkup of the students will be conducted once in a year.

### **Hostel**

There are hostel facilities for both boys and girls. 90 students who are non-local will be accommodated in boys hostel. 150 girls will be accommodated in the ladies hostel. A separate warden and menial staff look after the hostel activities. There is phone facility in both the hostels.

### **College Employees' Co-Op. Society**

This society helps to maintain and balance the financial needs of employees.

### **Alumni Association**

There is an alumni association of this college. Students who leave or pass out of the college are requested to enroll as members. The association keeps the members informed about the events happening. It will also work to keep old students associated with the college through letters and periodic reunions.

### **Language Lab**

A well equipped Language Lab has been set up in the college campus to enhance the language skills in English.

### **Placement Cell**
